COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased at net of \$312 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending February 23, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$185 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$95 million for unclassified loans and \$52 million in loans for primary metals.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$69 million in loans for commodity dealers.
