COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$325 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending March 30, 1977.

The principal net decreases were \$123 million for unclassified loans, \$94 million in loans for communication and \$42 million in loans for primary metals.

The largest offsetting increase was \$46 million in loans for services.
