COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$163 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending April 20, 1977.

The principal net changes were \$135 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$91 million in loans for mining and \$68 million in loans for services.

The largest offselling decrease was \$129 million in loans for other public utilities.
