For immediate release May 18, 1977 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$61 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending May 11, 1977.

The principal net changes were \$220 million for unclassified loans, \$107 million in loans for mining and \$96 million in all other loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$172 million in loans for other public utilities.
