COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$179 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending May 25, 1977.

The principal net changes were \$98 million in loans for commodity dealers, -\$97 million for unclassified loans and \$45 million in loans for other durable goods.

The largest offsetting increase was \$66 million in loans for mining.

AN ADDITIONAL RE-CLASSIFICATION IN SAN FRANCISCO DISTRICT EFFECTIVE MARCH 31, 1976, CHANGED TOTAL UNCLASSIFIED LOANS AND TOTAL COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS -\$493 MILLION.
