COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$269 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 15, 1977.

The principal net changes were \$183 million for unclassified loans, \$152 million in loans for commodity dealers and \$122 million in loans for bankers acceptances.

The largest offsetting increase was \$93 million in loans for textiles, apparel, and leather.
