COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$602 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 15, 1977.

The principal net changes were \$184 million in loans for mining, \$106 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$88 million in loans for other public utilities.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$105 million for unclassified loans.
