### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,287 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 22, 1977.

The principal net changes were \$258 million for unclassified loans, \$197 million in loans for other wholesale and \$147 million in loans for mining.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$51 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
