For immediate release July 7, 1977 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$13 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending June 29, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$135 million in loans for bankers acceptances, \$106 million for unclassified loans and \$104 million for foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$185 million in loans for machinery.
