COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$402 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending July 27, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$127 million in loans for retail trade, \$86 million in loans for textiles, apparel, and leather and \$84 million for unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$57 million in loans for food, liquor and tobacco.
