COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$466 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending August 3, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$137 million in unclassified loans, \$104 million in loans for commodity dealers and \$84 million in loans for other nondurable goods.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$132 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
