COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$233 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending August 10, 1977.

The principal net decreases were \$128 million in unclassified loans, \$106 million in loans for other public utilities and \$100 million in loans for commodity dealers.

The largest offsetting increase was \$89 million in all other loans.
