COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$150 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ending August 24, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$109 million in loans for Retail Trade and \$74 million in loans for Bankers acceptances.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$132 million in loans for Transportation Equipment.
