COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$35 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending September 14, 1977.

The principal net decreases were \$233 millions in loans for Bankers Acceptances and \$108 million in loans for Public Utilities.

The largest offsetting increase was \$200 million in loans for Durable Goods Manufacturing.
