### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,065 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial Banks during the week ending September 21, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$180 million in loans for construction and \$75 million in loans for mining (including crude petroleum and natural gas).

The largest offsetting decrease was \$96 million in loans for retail trade.
