### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$481 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending November 30.

The principal net increases were \$254 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$103 million in loans for transportation equipment.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$75 million in loans for textiles, apparel, and leather.
