COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,338 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending December 21, 1977.

The principal net increases were \$341 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$227 million in loans for mining, including crude petroleum and natural gas.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$124 million in loans for retail trade.
