COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$1,241 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending January 11.

The principal net decreases were \$608 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$196 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting increase was \$83 million in loans for retail trade.
