### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$180 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending January 25.

The principal net decreases were \$691 million in loans for bankers acceptance and \$130 million in loans for public utilities.

The largest offsetting increase was \$165 million in loans for wholesale trade.
