COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$326 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the week ending February 22, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$122 million in loans for chemicals and rubber and \$77 million in loans for wholesale trade.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$76 million in loans for foreign commercial and industrial loans.
