COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$506 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending March 8, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$124 million in loans for wholesale trade and \$88 million in loans for chemicals and rubber.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$129 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
