COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$131 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending March 29, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$231 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$59 million in loans for commodity dealers.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$65 million in loans for public utilities.
