COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$766 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending April 19, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$135 million in loans for mining (including crude petroleum and natural gas) and \$104 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$230 million in loans for transportation.
