COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$96 million as Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending May 24, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$102 million in loans for Retail Trade and \$96 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$84 million in loans for Chemicals and Rubber.
