COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,391 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending June 21, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$191 million in loans for mining (including crude petroleum and natural gas) and \$188 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$102 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
