COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$73 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending July 26, 1978.

The principal net decreases were \$102 million in loans for food, liquor and tobacco and \$62 million in loans for foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The largest offsetting increase was \$58 million in loans for machinery.
