COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$662 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending August 9, 1978.

The principal net decreases were \$256 millions in loans for bankers acceptances and \$124 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting increase was \$73 million in loans for transportation equipment.
