### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$764 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending October 25, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$266 million in loans for bankers acceptances and \$154 million in loans for retail trade.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$111 million in loans for transportation equipment.
