COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$46 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the week ending November 29, 1978.

The principal net decreases were \$101 million in loans for textiles, apparel, and tobacco and \$83 million in loans for primary metals.

The largest offsetting increase was \$113 million in loans for bankers acceptances.
