COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$167 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the week ending December 13, 1978.

The principal net decreases were \$117 million in loans for retail trade and \$64 million in loans for machinery.

The largest offsetting increase was \$82 million in loans for chemicals and rubber.
