COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$905 million at Weekly Reporting Large Commercial banks during the Week ending December 20, 1978.

The principal net increases were \$423 million in loans for transportation equipment and \$194 million in loans for services.

The largest offsetting decrease was \$112 million in loans for retail trade.
