

## PRESS STATEMENT.

April 26, 1919

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's regular weekly statement of total debits to deposit account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by about 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday April 16 and April 23.

Following the unusually large total reported for the week preceding the Easter holidays, debits to individual account for all districts, except Richmond and Dallas, show an 11 per cent recession, nearly all the large centers reporting smaller amounts than the week before. Aggregate debits to bank account show a 6 per cent decrease for the week, the Cleveland, Atlanta and Minneapolis districts showing larger figures than for the previous week, notwithstanding reductions in the corresponding total debits to individual account reported by these districts.

The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for 151 centers reporting complete data for both weeks. Figures of reporting clearing houses by Federal Reserve districts are as follows:
