

## PRESS STATEMENT.

May 10, 1919

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's regular weekly statement of total debits to deposit account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by about 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday April 30 and May 7, 1919.

Aggregate debits to individual account show a further increase of 3 per cent over the corresponding total for the immediately preceding week, all Federal Reserve districts, except those of New York and Minneapolis reporting substantial gains. The total for New York City, while about 55 millions less than the week before, is still considerably above the average weekly total for the present year. Pittsburgh, Detroit and St. Louis, likewise report smaller weekly debits to individual account than the week before.

Debits to bank account were about 8 per cent larger than the week before, increases being shown for all districts, except Kansas City. For New York City an increase in debits to bank account of over 10 per cent is shown.

The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for 152 centers reporting complete data for both weeks. Figures of reporting clearing houses by Federal Reserve districts are as follows:
