BANK DEBITS.

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's weekly statement of debits to individual account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by over 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday November 5 and October 29, of the present year, and in case of most of the reporting centers also the weekly period ending a year earlier, i.e., Nov. 6, 1918.

Aggregate debits to individual account were slightly less than the week before, the clearing house banks at New York, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Baltimore and Minneapolis reporting substantial decreases, while the banks at the other important cities showed larger figures for the week under review than for the preceding week. As compared with corresponding 1918 figures, available for 143 cities, debits to individual account showed an increase of about 45 per cent, all the larger cities participating in the increase. Of the total increase about two-thirds was the share of the New York City banks.

The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for 156 centers reporting complete data for the two most recent weeks, also like figures for the 143 centers for which data are available for the past week and the week ending November 6, of last year.
