BANK DEBITS

Below is given the Federal Reserve Board's weekly statement of debits to individual account, reported through the Federal Reserve banks by over 150 of the country's more important clearing houses. Transactions cover the weekly periods ending Wednesday, April 7 and March 31 of the present year and April 9, 1919. The statement closes with a recapitulation giving comparative figures by reserve districts for centers reporting complete data for the three weeks under review.

Debits to individual account reported by 149 of the principal clearing house cities aggregated 8,960 millions, as compared with 9,560 millions the week before, the decrease amounting to about 600 millions, or 7 per cent. Considerably more than average decreases are shown for Boston and New York, the decrease for the latter city being 690 millions, that is, more than the aggregate decrease for the 149 cities. On the other hand, the figures for other important centers, including St. Louis, Cleveland, Baltimore and Los Angeles, show considerable increases over totals reported the week before, while decreases for centers outside of New York and Boston are relatively small.

For the week ending April 9, 1919, debits to individual account aggregated 7,256 millions, or 1,704 millions less than for the corresponding week of this year. The current year's figures are larger for all the important centers except Kansas City.
