BANK DEBITS

Aggregate debits to individual account of 8,866 millions, as against 9,382 millions the week before, are shown by 156 of the country's more important Clearing House Associations for the week ending September 29. Owing mainly to the fact that the previous week saw the clearance of a large volume of income tax checks, total debits for the most recent week show reductions for all the important centers, except Pittsburgh and New Orleans.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1919, aggregate debits for the week under review show a decline of 778 millions, the decrease for the Clearing House Banks in New York City alone being 1,093 millions, while all the other important centers, except Dallas, report larger figures than last year. More than average increases in debits are noted for Boston, Pittsburgh and Chicago.
