BANK DEBITS

Aggregate debits to individual account of 10,037 millions, as against 8,845 millions the week before, are shown by 154 of the country's more important Clearing House Associations for the week ending October 6th. All the important centers, except New Orleans, reported larger figures than for the preceding week, but 725 millions of the total increase of 1,192 millions was shown for New York City, where end-of-month and end-of-quarter settlements of interest, dividends, and contractual obligations are especially heavy.

As compared with the corresponding week of 1919, aggregate debits for the week under review show an increase of 220 millions, all the important centers, except Boston and New York, reporting larger totals.
