BANK DEBITS

Aggregate debits to individual account reported for their members by 150 of the country's leading Clearing Houses for the week ending October 20 owing largely to the great volume of Government transactions were 2,335 millions larger than for the preceding week, all the more important cities, except Minneapolis, showing substantial increases for the week. For New York City the increase for the week is given as 1,423 millions, constituting over 60 per cent of the total increase shown.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1919 total debits for the week under review show an increase of 112.5 millions, though the weekly total for the Clearing House banks in New York City was 404 millions less than in 1919. All the other larger centers, except Boston and Dallas, show substantially larger weekly totals than last year.
