BANK DEBITS

Aggregate increases of 899 millions in debits to individual account are indicated by reports received from 152 of the country's leading Clearing House Associations, the total for the week ending November 10 being 9,596 millions, as against 8,697 millions the week before. Larger totals are shown for all of the more important centers, except Boston, Cleveland, Baltimore and Dallas.

As compared with the corresponding total in 1919 debits for the week under review are 1205 millions smaller. For New York City alone this year's figures are 1408 millions smaller than for the corresponding week last year, and smaller reductions are reported by many of the other centers. Among the centers having larger totals than a year ago, Pittsburgh, New Orleans, Chicago, Minneapolis and San Francisco may be mentioned.
