BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 153 important clearing house centers, declined from \$7,579,000,000 for the week ending July 6 to \$7,319,000,000 for the week ending July 13, a reduction of \$260,000,000, or about 3 per cent, in spite of the fact that the earlier week contained only five business days. While the total volume of debits for all reporting centers was smaller for the week under review, many of the leading cities report increased totals, the decrease for New York City alone, where stock exchange transactions were at an exceptionally low level, being \$313,000,000, or about 8 per cent.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1920, debits for the week ending July 13 are smaller by \$1,980,000,000, or about 21 per cent, this lag being comparable with 11 per cent shown for the preceding week. Smaller figures for the week under review, as compared with last year, are reported for all the leading centers, with the exception of Detroit.
