BANK DEBITS

Volume of business, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 154 important clearing house centers for the week ending November 9, shows a reduction of \$1,248,000,000, due in part to the fact that the most recent week included election day, a legal holiday in most of the cities, and in part to the fact that the preceding week saw the regular end-of-month expansion of business. Smaller totals are reported for all the leading centers, except New Orleans and Kansas City, the decrease for New York City alone being \$946,000,000, or more than three-fourths of the total reduction.

As compared with the week ending November 10, 1920, debits for the week under review show a decrease of \$2,266,000,000, or 24 per cent, the reason for this relatively large difference being chiefly that the week this year included election day, while last year election day was on November 2 and was included in the preceding week's returns.
