BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending January 25, as measured by total debits to individual accounts reported by 165 of the country's more important clearing houses, totaled \$7,572,000,000, or \$1,356,000,000 less than for the preceding week. Smaller totals are reported by all the larger centers, the decrease for New York City alone being \$843,000,000, or over 60 per cent of the total decrease for the week.

As compared with totals for the week ending January 26, 1921, debits for the week under review show a shrinkage of \$735,000,000, or of nearly 9 per cent. Of the larger centers only Los Angeles reports a larger volume of transactions than last year. Less than average decreases are shown for Boston, New York City and Philadelphia, while Cleveland, Pittsburgh and San Francisco show the largest relative declines, as compared with figures for the corresponding week in 1921.
