BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending February 15 shows a decrease, as compared with the preceding week, of \$721,000,000, or about 9 per cent. This decrease is due in part to the fact that February 12 was Lincoln's birthday, which was observed as a holiday on Monday, February 13, in many districts. All the leading centers, except Detroit and San Francisco, report reduced totals.

As compared with the week ending February 15, 1921, the volume of business for the report week was smaller by \$316,000,000, or about 4 per cent. Smaller figures were reported by all the leading centers, except New York, Detroit and Los Angeles. The most pronounced declines are shown for Boston, Pittsburgh, Chicago, St. Louis and San Francisco.

The total number of centers reporting this week is 235, of which 166 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
