BANK DEBITS

Tuesday, February 22, being observed as a holiday in all the Federal reserve districts, the present statement of bank debits closes on Tuesday, February 21, and the figures consequently represent five days' transactions. As compared with the previous week, which included Lincoln's birthday, the week under review shows an increase of \$84,000,000 in the volume of business. The increase for New York City alone was \$172,000,000, or about twice as much as the total increase for all reporting centers.

As compared with the week ending February 23, 1921, the volume of business for the report week was larger by \$664,000,000, or about 10 per cent. The largest increase is shown for New York City, where the volume of business was about 24 per cent above last year's level. On the other hand, Baltimore, St. Louis, Kansas City and Pittsburgh report smaller totals than a year ago, the decrease for Pittsburgh being nearly 50 per cent.

The total number of centers reporting this week is 234, of which 164 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
