BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending April 19, as measured by total debits to individual accounts reported for their members by 165 clearing house associations, totaled \$8,797,000,000, compared with \$8,414,000,000 for the preceding week. Larger figures are shown for all the leading centers, except Cleveland and Pittsburgh. New York City reports an increase of \$269,000,000, substantial gains for the week being shown for Chicago, Detroit and San Francisco.

As compared with the week ending April 20, 1921, the volume of business for the report week shows an increase of \$931,000,000, or of about 12 per cent. For New York City, because of the greatly increased activity of the stock market, the increase as compared with last year, is \$1,003,000,000, or about 26 per cent. Changes reported for the other centers were relatively much smaller, the decreases in the aggregate more than offsetting the increases shown.

The total number of centers reporting this week is 240, of which 165 are included in the Summary by Federal reserve districts.
