BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending May 24 was \$8,767,000,000, marking a decrease of \$163,000,000, or of 2 per cent, from the total of \$8,930,000,000 reported for the preceding week. Smaller figures are shown for all the leading centers, except Boston, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Baltimore, Chicago and Detroit.

As compared with the week ending May 25, 1921, the volume of business for the report week was larger by \$1,574,000,000, or about 22 per cent, compared with a difference of only 2 per cent shown the week before. For New York City the increase for the year was \$1,279,000,000, or about 36 per cent. Larger figures this year than last are reported for all the leading centers, except Pittsburgh, Kansas City and San Francisco.

The volume of business is measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in clearing house centers. The number of centers reporting this week is 245, of which 166 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
