BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending August 16 was 7,969 millions, marking an increase of 161 millions, or about 2 per cent, over the total of 7,808 millions reported for the preceding week. While the total for all reporting centers combined was larger than the week before, which is in accordance with the usual mid-month swell, many of the leading centers showed smaller figures, particularly New York and Kansas City.

As compared with the week ending August 17, 1921, the volume of business for the week under review shows an increase of 794 millions, or 11 per cent. While the majority of leading centers report larger figures than a year ago, considerable recessions are shown for some of the cities, particularly Boston, Baltimore and Chicago.

The volume of business is measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading centers. The total number of centers reporting this week is 248, of which 165 are included in the summary by Federal reserve district.
