BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending August 23, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading centers, totaled \$7,460,000,000, or \$509,000,000 less than the total for the preceding week. All of the larger cities, except New Orleans, Detroit, and Dallas, show smaller figures than the week before. New York City reports a decline of \$229,000,000 or of 5.6 per cent for the week, as compared with a decline of 6.4 per cent for all reporting centers combined.

As compared with the week ending August 24, 1921, the volume of business for the week under review shows an increase of \$1,089,000,000, or 17 per cent. Increases over last year's figures are shown for all the large centers, except Baltimore, Chicago, and Minneapolis. New York City reports an increase over last year of \$847,000,000, or of 78 per cent of the total increase shown.

The total number of centers reporting this week is 248, of which 165 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve districts.
