BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending September 20, as measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading centers, aggregated \$9,413,000,000, or \$1,180,000,000 in excess of the total reported for the previous week. This increase is due apparently in part to charges on account of tax payments, also of subscriptions to newly issued Treasury certificates, but reflects also the larger volume of business reported from all parts of the country. All the important centers report larger figures than the week before. Larger than average gains are shown for Boston, Philadelphia, Baltimore, Detroit, Dallas and San Francisco.

As compared with the week ending September 21, 1921, the volume of business for the week under review shows an increase of \$898,000,000, or of about 11 per cent. For New York City an average rate of increase of \$702,500,000 is shown. Increases over corresponding 1921 figures are also shown for all the other larger centers, except Pittsburgh, Baltimore, Detroit, Milwaukee and San Francisco.

The total number of centers reporting for the week is 249, of which 166 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
