BANK DEBITS

Volume of business for the week ending October 11 was \$9,261,000,000, marking a decline of \$380,000,000, or 4 per cent, from the total reported for the preceding week, which witnessed a large volume of end-of-quarter settlements. Smaller figures are shown for all the leading centers, except Atlanta.

For the corresponding week in 1921 the volume of business was \$6,770,000,000. The exceptionally large spread between the figures of this year and last year, amounting to 37 per cent of the smaller figure, is explained by the fact that in 1921 the week included October 12, Columbus day, which is observed as a holiday in most of the cities, while this year the week ended October 11 and contained full six business days.

The volume of business is measured by debits to individual accounts reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading centers. The total number of centers reporting this week is 242, of which 160 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
